

Records Fall As New Earswick Swimming Club Take Division 1 Title!!!



On Saturday 23rd September 2007 a team of 36 swimmers from New Earswick Swimming Club travelled to Hull to compete in the final Division 1 Gala of the year. The gala saw league leaders New Earswick compete against teams from South Hunsley, Bridlington and Whitby swimming clubs.

New Earswick were in fine form taking first place in 23 of the 48 events swam and after winning the first event the team led the gala from start to finish! The girls were once more in record breaking form, breaking four records on the night.

The first record to fall was the girls 14 and under medley relay team of Amber Moorcroft, Rebecca Galloway, Sarah Graves and Amy Taylor who lowered their previous record set at the last gala.

In the girls 14 and under 50m Breaststroke, 13 year old Rebecca Galloway broke the league record which had stood for 14 years!

The girls 12 and under 50m Freestyle was the next record to fall, with Laura Fieldhouse taking almost 2 seconds off the six year old record.

The final record to fall was the girls 12 and under Freestyle relay team of Darriane Helstrip, Hannah Sturdy, Steph Woodford and Laura Fieldhouse who lowered the teams record set at the last gala by almost 4 seconds.

The final event of the night saw New Earswick's girl's captain Emily Broadbent finish the open girls relay swim in style winning the race, her last for the club as she leaves for university.
